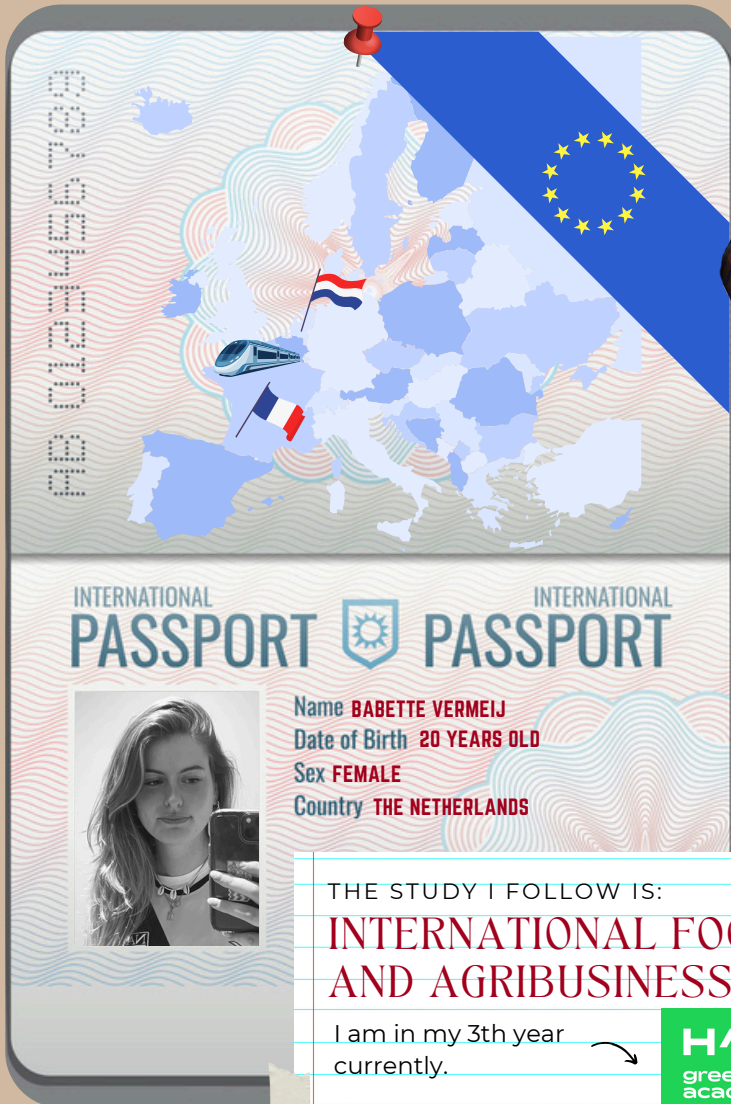




HALF YEAR MINOR IN BORDEAUX

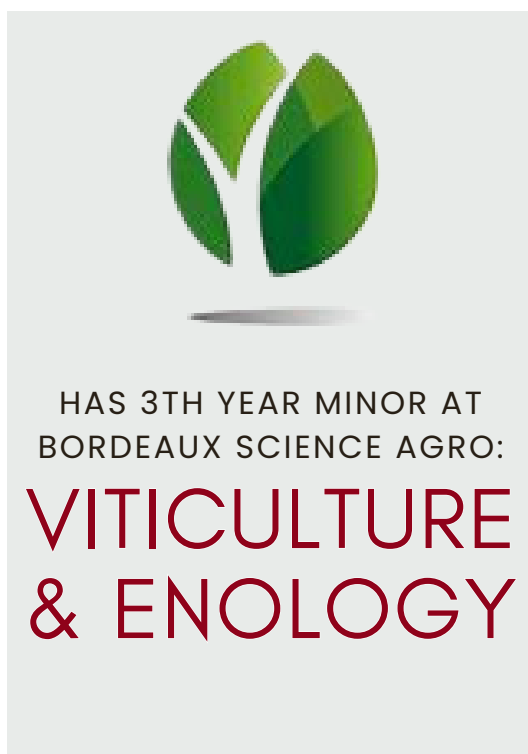
FUTURE GOALS

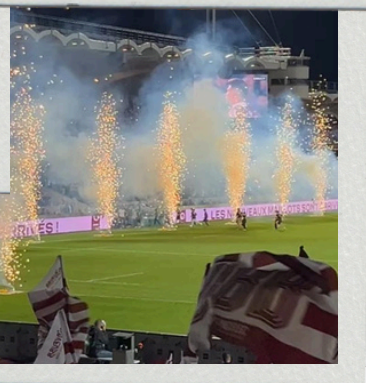
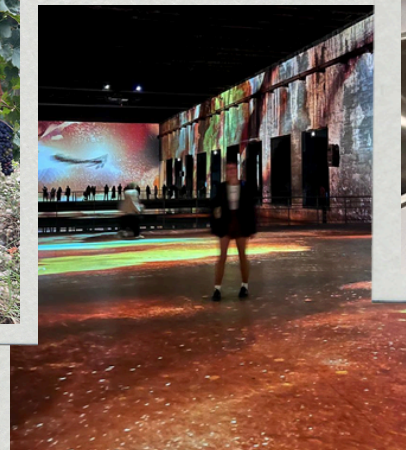
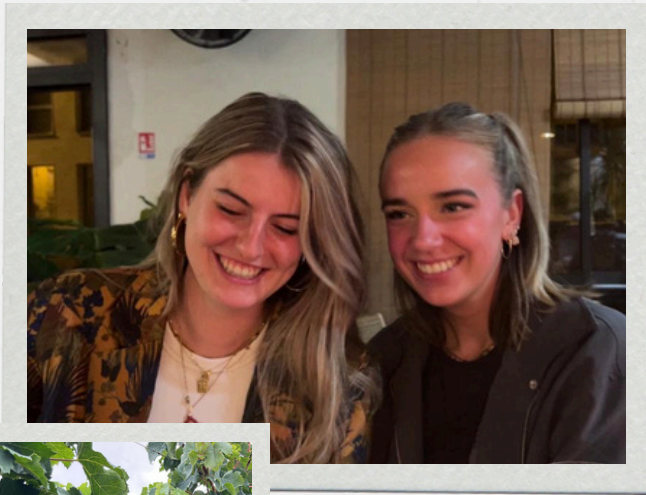
