To apply for a BBA in the Netherlands, you have to first create an account on Studielink. If your previous education was not taught entirely in English, you must provide proof of your English proficiency. HAS accepts an IELTS Academic overall score of 6.0, a TOEFL score of 80 (internet-based), 213 (computer-based) or 550 (paper-based), or a Cambridge ESOL certificate at B2 level.
